#3. Shopping.

Fall in Love with Blue Ridge.

You will fall in love with the authentic mountain towns of Blue Ridge and McCaysville. Blue Ridge was once considered an elite health resort because of its pure mineral waters. It was established as a railroad town, with the depot at its heart. Visitors would ride the train to town, eat dinner and take a leisurely walk to the mineral springs after dinner. Today, visitors still ride the train and take a walk along Main Street, enjoying the antique and specialty shops, galleries, restaurants, small town atmosphere and friendly people. A river runs through the



quaint town of McCaysville, twin city with Copperhill, Tennessee. Stand in both states at one time at the Blue Line, which marks the spot where Georgia ends and Tennessee begins. Here the Toccoa River becomes the Ocoee River, flowing northward into Tennessee.

Cool Places The Art Center Featuring the Galleries on East Main and seasonal rotating exhibits of work by local and regional artists. and the best fried apple pies – a true farm to table experience. Treat yourself to a farm tractor tour and u-pick strawberries, sweet cherries, blueberries and apples in season. Also see Mountainview Orchards, a traditional apple orchard and fruit market, and eat good Southern food at the Cider House Café.

Experience Living History.

Don't miss the train! Take a ride on the Blue Ridge Scenic Railway, which runs along the Toccoa River from Blue Ridge to McCaysville. Board the train at the historic depot in Blue Ridge. The view changes with the seasons, wildflowers and mountain laurel in the spring, rhododendron in the summer, gorgeous foliage in the fall and a ride with Santa and his elves for Christmas. Special trips are planned throughout the year, including the Easter Eggspress in the spring and Pumpkin Train in the fall. Open April through December. #7. Hiking.

Hike the Appalachian Trail & Discover a Local Waterfall.



Two of the greatest outdoor adventures in the world begin in Fannin County. Both the Appalachian and Benton MacKaye Trails start at the top of Springer Mountain. There are over 300 miles of hiking trails in the area, including short trails suitable for beginning hikers and families. Try this hike to experience the Appalachian Trail and see beautiful Long Creek Falls. Take snacks and

lots of water; this is a half-day adventure. Get a map to all our local waterfalls online at www.blueridgemountains.com or at our Welcome Center.

Appalachian Trail Hike to Long Creek Falls: From Blue Ridge, go south on Aska Road 13.5 miles to end. Turn right onto Newport Road, go 4.5 miles to end. Turn left onto Doublehead Gap Road and continue on this road about .8 miles to intersection with dirt-gravel USFS Road 58 intersecting sharply from right. Turn onto FS 58 and continue into forest and uphill 5.3 miles to Three Forks. The parking area is on the right at Noontootla Creek, a beautiful trout stream. The trail to Long Creek Falls is on the left.



Float the Beautiful Toccoa River.

The most popular family pastime in the summer is probably tubing the clear, chilly Toccoa River either above the Lake Blue Ridge dam on Aska Road or below in McCaysville. But there are lots of ways to enjoy our rivers, streams and lakes, including rafting the exciting Ocoee River, renting canoes or kayaks, pontooning or jet skiing on Lake Blue Ridge, or even surfing on the river or the lake.

Morganton Point: From Blue Ridge follow Hwy 515 east toward Blairsville and turn right at the junction with Hwy 60 to Morganton. In Morganton, stay straight until you see the signs to Morganton Point; turn right and go 1/2 mile to the park entrance.

Ocoee Whitewater Center: From Blue Ridge, follow Hwy 5 north to McCaysville, turn left at the end and follow Hwy 68 to Hwy 64. Exit to Hwy 64, turn left and drive east about 5.5 miles to the Whitewater Center.

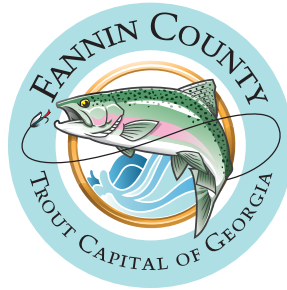

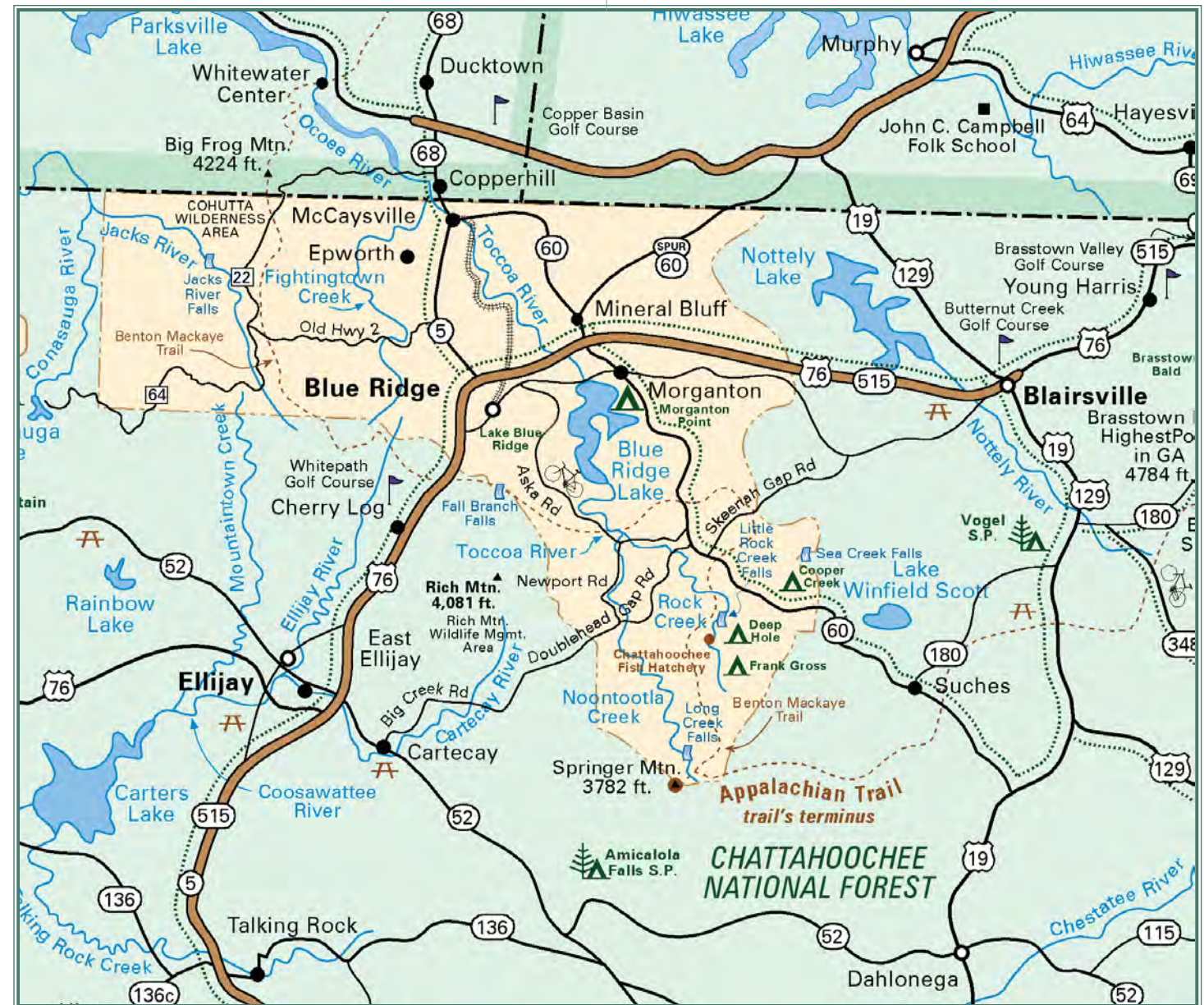
