## MERCIER ORCHARDS

**1** Mercier Orchards is the only apple orchard in Georgia that grows, presses, ferments and bottles their own hard apple cider and farm wines. Mercier's is also the first producer of Hard Cider in the state. Visit their 120-acre farm and enjoy a round of tasting; hard ciders include Grumpy Granny, Adele's Choice, Black Bee, Apple Bramble, Lone Tree, Old #3 and Just Peachy. Their farm wines include Fall Harvest Apple, Blackberry Winter and Summer Sweet Peach wines. Mercier's also has tastings of some of the best regional wines produced in the Georgia Mountains. ## SERENBERRY VINEYARDS

**2** Serenberry is a charming farm winery just a few country miles from Blue Ridge. Visit Serenberry and experience the simple and serene pleasures of the North Georgia Mountains surrounded by nature's down-to-earth gifts of life, people, and wine at the vineyard.

The farm winery has seven to eight wines in the bottle, including Railroad Red and Blue Ridge Red. Tastings are four for \$4 or seven for \$7. Enjoy sipping on the open air patio in a beautiful, relaxed setting. Grumpy Old Men Brewing was established in 2012 by two "old retired guys" who were home brewing in an outdoor shower and graduated to their brewery on East Main in Blue Ridge.
